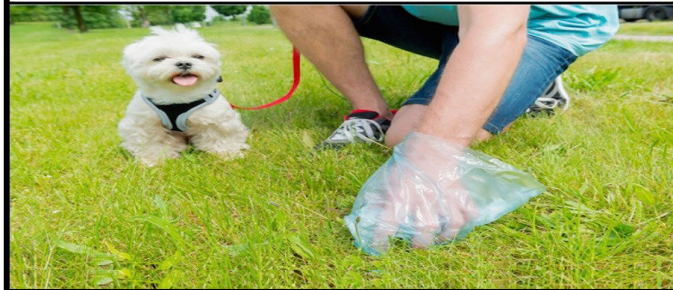

Four OHP residents took steps toward increased neighborhood preparedness by attending the November 4th through the 6th Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) course at the Bexar County Fire Marshal's Office.

During the approximately 20-hour course OHPNA President Kevin Jernigan, 2nd Vice President Roy Valdez, Jr., Roy's wife Priscilda, and daughter Amber, learned a variety of safety skills, including medical treatment for serious injuries, removing victims from unsafe areas, proper fire extinguisher use in a residential setting, indoor and outdoor searches for victims, how to safely shut off utilities to damaged structures, and a basic understanding of emergency response. OHPNA 1st Vice President Morgan Montalvo served as the course manager-evaluator and one of seven instructors.

The course employs team building strategies to help neighborhoods, businesses, faith communities and schools prepare for and survive a variety of hazards. Community Emergency Response Teams originated in California in the mid-1980s in response to earthquakes and other major disasters that quickly can overwhelm first responder agencies. All CERT training is provided free of cost by experienced emergency responders.

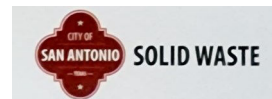
