For San Antonio drivers, school zone speeding fines start at \$206 for the first extra 10 miles per hour over the speed limit. For every additional mile per hour over, the fine increases \$5.

Use of cell phones is banned not only in active school zones, but while driving on any school property, including pick-up lanes and school parking lots.
