Finally some free water for the yards. After MANY weeks with barely a trace of rain, a nice shower may have dropped as much as a half inch of rain on the area. Hopefully this will be a precursor of things to come. As the Fall season takes over from Summer, the fronts should start making their presence known and kick off a bit more rain before we hit the mandatory water-ratting level. Right now we are within about 5 feet of the aquifer hitting that level - after starting the Summer close to 20 feet above average.

Many people were wondering what was all the activity along the Thousand Oaks perimeter for a couple of weeks. It was Verizon running their 5G Optic Fiber cable through the area, and it should complete very soon.

The City did a major clean out of our runoff ditch that runs out toward Thousand Oaks from Pebble Breeze. It is now smooth and clear of debris in advance of the return of rain and runoff to our area.

Neighbor's Night Out, which is the first Tuesday in October, occurs on the FIRST day of October, so effectively the end of this month! That also means the Neighborhood Garage sale the first Saturday in October is not that far away. It is not too soon to start organizing and pricing those objects for sale, as there are just a couple of weeks remaining to get it all done. (Don't forget the Garage sale permit, which you can pick up at HEB.) On a side note but probably totally unrelated - we are now under 100 shopping days til Christmas!

As the Fall activities pick up and the time crunch closes in - please remember to take time and lock your cars, don't leave anything in sight in your vehicles and just be generally cautious.

While crime has not been a major item reported lately, a lot comes from targets of opportunity. Please do not let yourself be a target. And as always, school is in full swing, so be mindful of the foot traffic and flashing lights!

With Christmas looming in the future and the neighborhood garage sale right around the corner, don't forget the best hiding places go early. See you at National Night Out on 1 Oct!
