## 2023 OHPNA SCHOLARSHIP

Apply now for the Oak Hollow Park Scholarship!

Criteria:

- The applicant must be a high school senior graduating in 2024 (or adult seeking their first certificate or degree) and planning to attend college, professional school or trade school.

- Parents or guardians must be members of the OHP Neighborhood Association in 2023-2024, as well as having a history of membership; adults must have a history of membership and be OHP Neighborhood Association members in 2023-24.

- Applicant must submit a completed application.

- Applicant must have two reference letters.

- Applicant must write a 500-700 word essay on the importance of volunteering.

- Applicant must have a GPA no lower than 3.0.

- Applicant must have participated as a volunteer in community, church or civic activities. This also includes OHPNA service opportunities.

- Applicant should include a copy of their acceptance to institution.

- If you are planning on taking a gap year you can still apply for this year's scholarship.

- Winners will be announced at the May OHPNA Board Meeting.

The selection committee is composed of three teachers from nearby schools that do not serve OHP students and a current OHPNA board member who will serve as a non-voting OHP Scholarship coordinator.

As always, numbers and amounts awarded are determined by donations to the scholarship fund. If you have any questions or would like to request an application, please text me at 210-885-9472.

The application deadline for the May 2024 award is March 31st.
