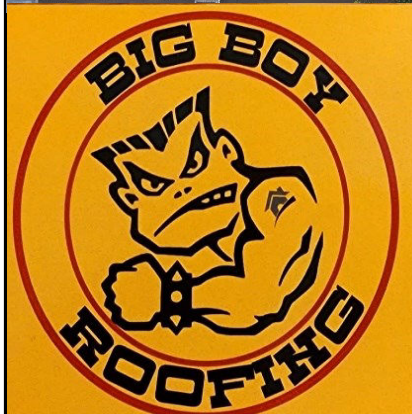

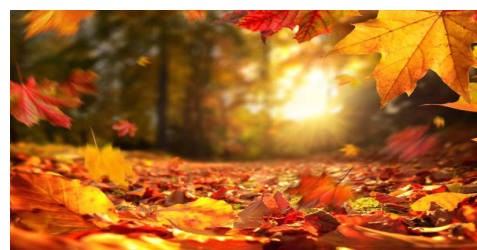

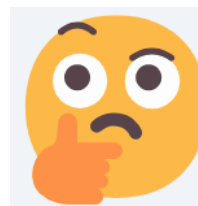

CHEESE DIP

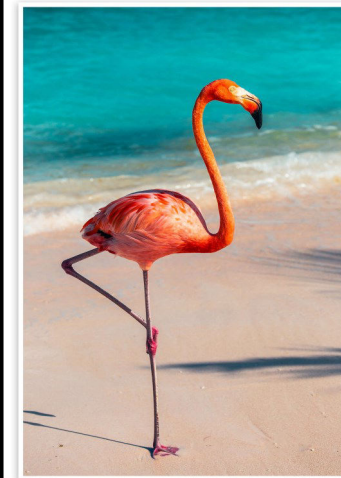

Dues are only \$40.00 per year. Oak Hollow Park DOES NOT have an HOA, so dues are NOT mandatory. However, what you donate:

- And ONLY OHPNA members get an annual neighborhood directory each September to keep in touch with their neighbors, the option of receiving a paper Pebbles, as well as receive an OHPNA Value Card for use at selected food trucks!
