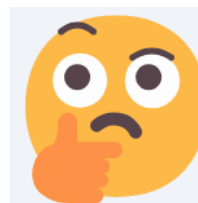

JULIA RODRIGUEZ

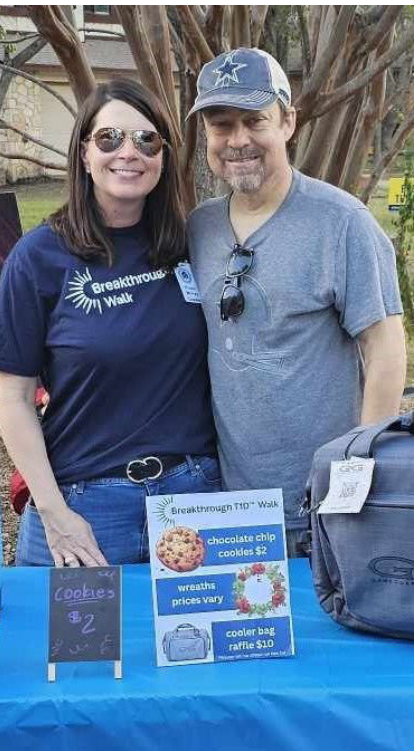

As many of you know, Neighbors Together (National Night Out) starts Oak Hollow Park's annual membership drive! I encourage all residents to join the OAK HOLLOW PARK NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION!

Dues are only \$40.00 per year. Oak Hollow Park DOES NOT have an HOA, so dues are NOT mandatory. However, what you donate:
