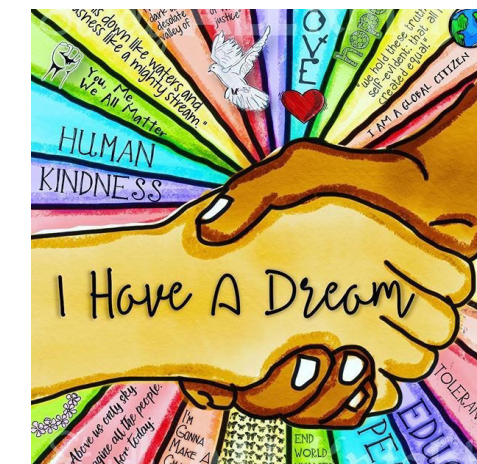

ELECTION RESULTS: Alan Langhoff – 35 votes, Libby Duncan – 34 votes, John Paniagua – 34 votes, Ruthie Szenasi – 34 votes, Suzanne Baumgartel – 32 votes, Carlos Bennett – 32 votes, Kristin Morrey – 32 votes, Kathy Nickeson – 32 votes, Roy Valdez – 29 votes. All accepted their positions except Roy Valdez, who will be retiring from the Board. Write-in votes were: Julieann Chassey – 4 votes, Kathy Babb – 2 votes, Chris Chassey – 2 votes, Les Earls – 2 votes, Teresa Szuminski – 2 votes. Les Earls and Teresa Szuminski declined their positions. As of this writing, still waiting on word back from the other write-ins.

APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS: Kevin nominated Alan Langhoff for President, John Paniagua for First Vice President, Kristin Morrey for Second Vice President, and Suzanne Baumgartel as Secretary. Treasurer will be decided at a later date. All officers accepted their nominations and were approved unanimously by the board members in attendance.

Kevin discussed realignment of duties with board members.

OHPNA SCHOLARSHIP

Apply now for the Oak Hollow Park Scholarship!

Criteria:

- The applicant must be a high school senior graduating in 2025 (or adult seeking their first certificate or degree) and planning to attend college, professional school or trade school.

- Parents or guardians must be members of the OHP Neighborhood Association in 2024-2025, as well as having a history of membership; adults must have a history of membership and be OHP Neighborhood Association members in 2024-25.

- Applicant must submit a completed application.

- Applicant must have two reference letters.

- Applicant must write a 500-700 word essay on the importance of volunteering.

- Applicant must have a GPA no lower than 3.0.

- Applicant must have participated as a volunteer in community, church or civic activities. This also includes OHPNA service opportunities.

- Applicant should include a copy of their acceptance to institution.

- If you are planning on taking a gap year you can still apply for this year's scholarship.

- Winners will be announced at the May OHPNA Board Meeting.

The selection committee is composed of three teachers from nearby schools that do not serve OHP students and a current OHPNA board member who will serve as a non-voting OHP Scholarship coordinator.

As always, numbers and amounts awarded are determined by donations to the scholarship fund. If you have any questions you would like to request an application, please contact me at 210-885-9472.

The deadline for the May 2025 award is March 31st.
