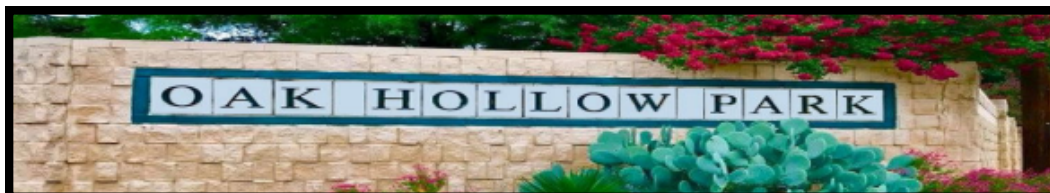

Neighbors Together - Oct 7 We plan to have grilled hot dogs to eat and will ask neighbors to volunteer to bring desserts to share. We will also plan to arrange for a bouncy house for the kids (same as last year) and that company also brings a popcorn machine. We also discussed having a membership table set up where people can pay for their yearly membership and also get a raffle ticket for prizes. Carlos agreed to bring a speaker and turn on some tunes for us, and Ruthie agreed to coordinate a table for rock painting.

Other items discussed

● Bush's ad - the owner of Bush's Chicken has agreed to offer our neighborhood a buy one get one free meal coupon that we can put in the Pebbles. The coupon will expire, but the owner said people could either bring in the paper coupon or they could just show it on their phone to redeem.

● The Board is working on offering alternative payment options for membership, because we have received some feedback that one issue is not having the convenience of online payment. We do offer Zelle, but some people's banks do not work with Zelle, so PayPal and Venmo have been requested. We looked into that and learned that, even as a non-profit, each transaction is charged a fee. We really cannot afford to give part of the membership fees away to these services, so we discussed the possibility of allowing folks to use those services as long as they will pay the service fee in ADDITION to the regular \$40 yearly membership fee. Kristin offered to post a poll on Facebook to see which of these services most people preferred.

We will not have a Board Meeting in October. Neighbors Together will count as our meeting. The next Board Meeting will be on Monday, November 3rd.

RECIPE FAVORITES

Buffalo Chicken Dip

Ingredients:

- 1 (10 ounce) can chunk chicken, drained
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup hot pepper sauce (such as Frank's RedHot)
- 2 (8 ounce) packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup ranch dressing
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- Blue cheese crumbles, for topping (optional)
- Frito corn chips

Instructions

- Beat cream cheese, ranch dressing, and red hot sauce.
- Fold in shredded chicken.
- Spread mixture into pie plate sprayed with Pam.
- Bake at 350 degrees Fahrenheit for 15 minutes.
- Add cheddar cheese to top.
- Bake an additional 10 to 15 minutes.
